

User guide for using smart identity card reader under different browsers

Apple Safari

1. Choose the HKIC symbol, and click <Read Card and Search> after a smart HKIC is inserted into smart identity card reader with **chip facing up**.

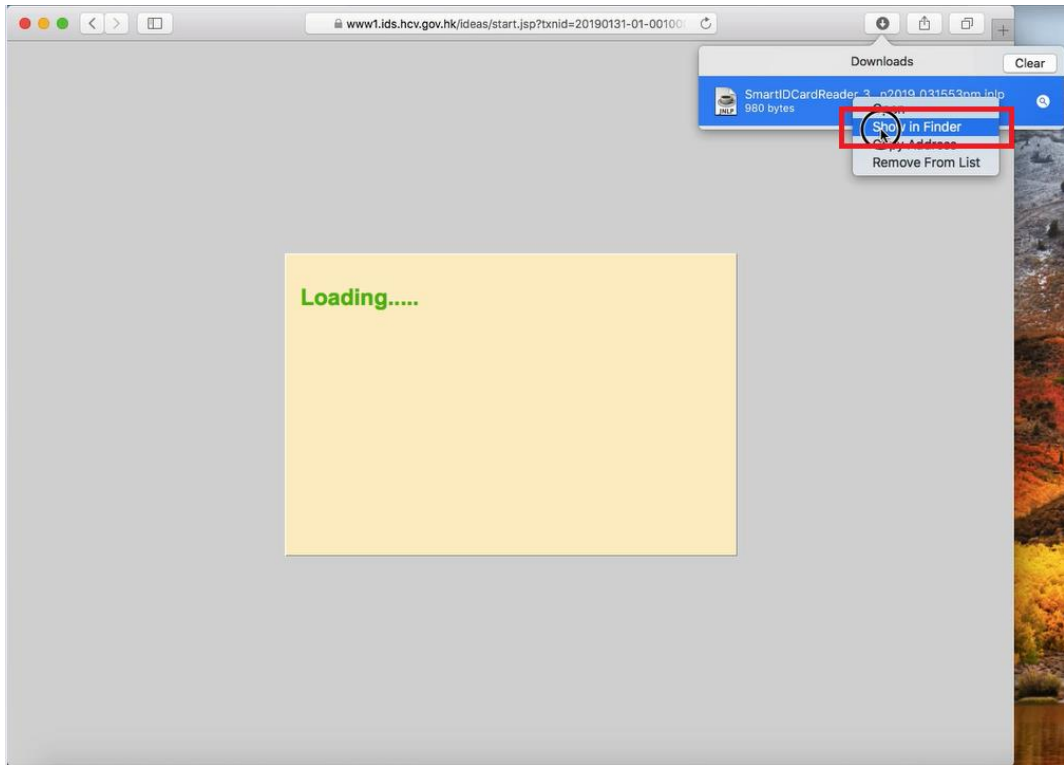

2. Click the download icon.

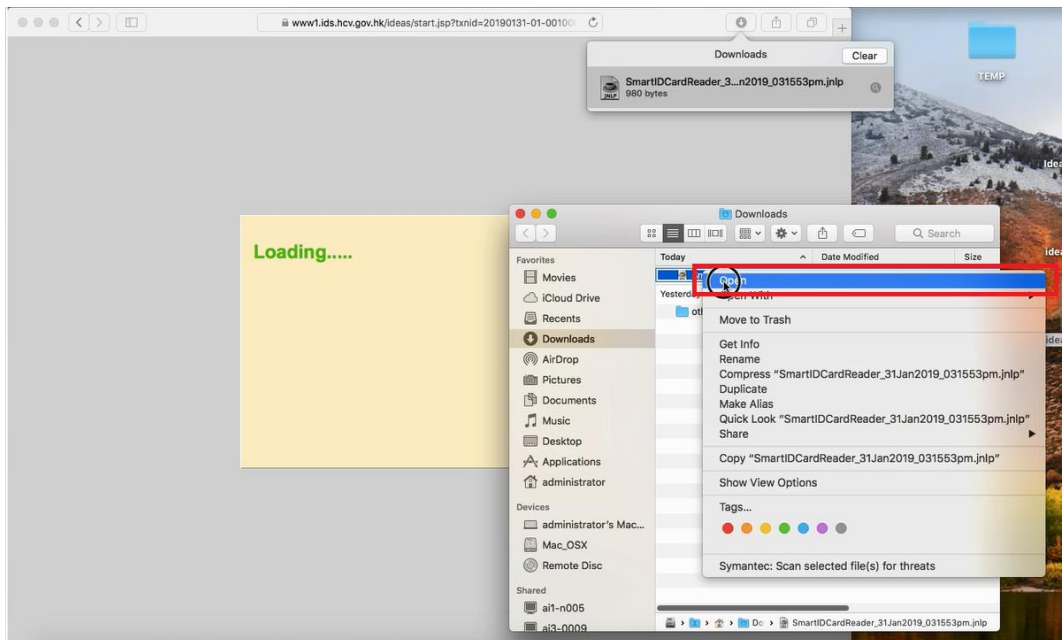

3. Right-click the JNLP file and select <Show in Finder>.

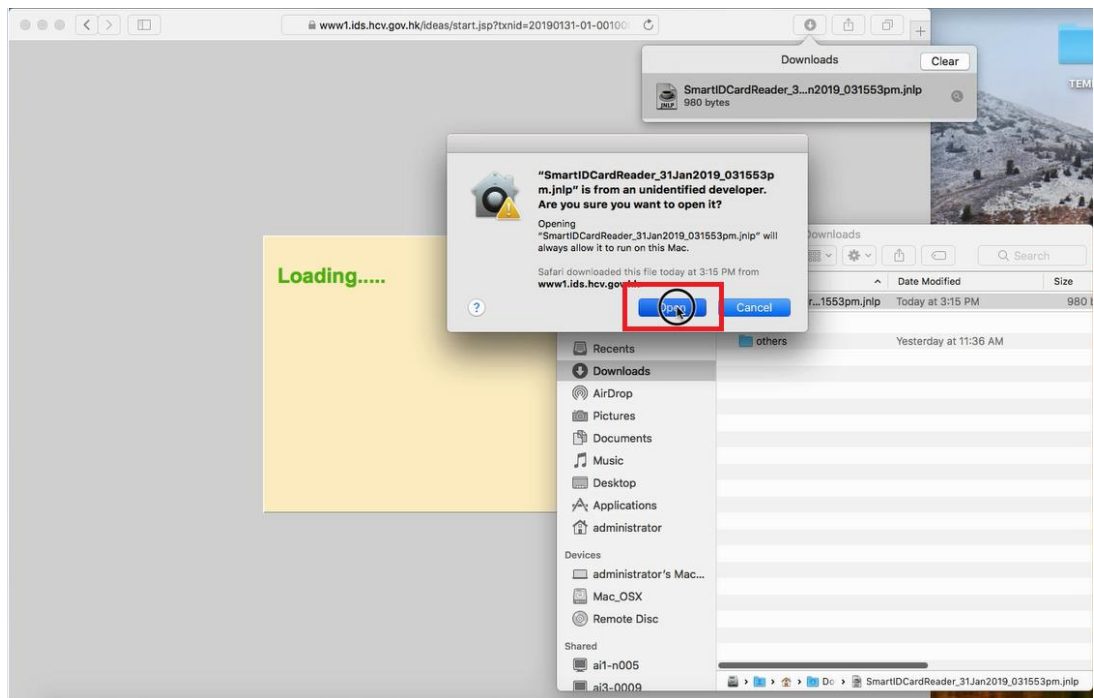


4. Right-click the JNLP file in Finder and select <Open>.

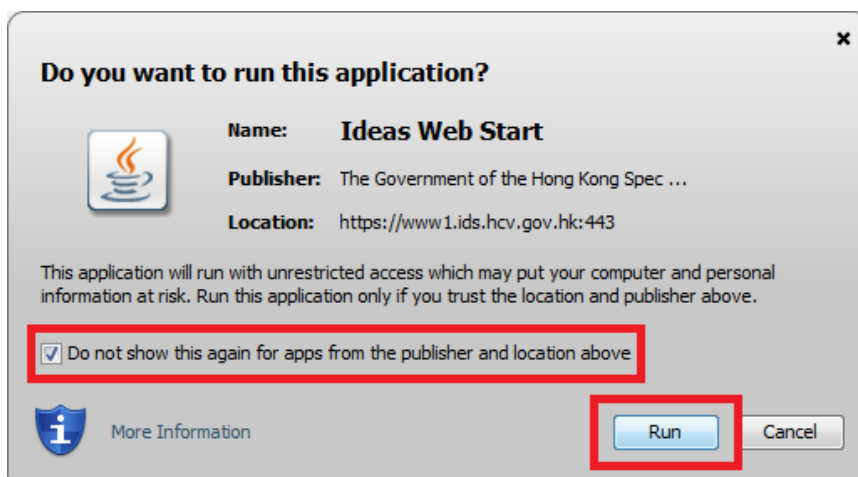
5. Click <Open>.



6. Wait until the splash screen dismisses (shown in first time only).

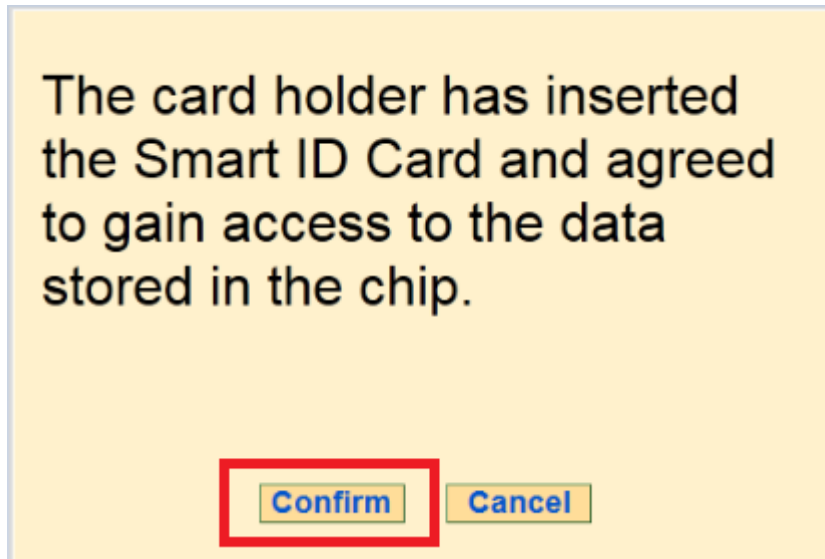


7. Check the “Do not show this again for apps from the publisher and location above” box and click <Run> (shown in first time only).
